### Rules of Entry:

**Eligibility:** Artists living in Oregon are invited to submit up to (3) entries in any media, except photography. All work must be display-ready upon arrival. Finish framed artwork can be no bigger than 12” in any direction. Commission rates paid to artists are 70% to UVAA members and 60% to non-members. Entries must be original works of art and entirely created by the entrant, no photography accepted. No work will be accepted into this show which is in violation of any copyright or which is a mechanical reproduction, such as a giclee print. Artwork must have been completed within the last two years. Work must not have been previously exhibited at UVAA.

**Entry Fee:** Non-refundable \$25 fee for 1–3 entries.

### Criteria:

- Entries will be judged from digital files only.
- Artists may not substitute another work for an accepted work nor withdraw the work once it is accepted.
- All entries must be for sale.
- Finished framed artwork can be no bigger than 12” in any direction.
- UVAA reserves the right to refuse upon arrival any piece of artwork not of an acceptable quality, which was not discernable from the digital image. UVAA reserves the right to refuse upon arrival any work that does not match the image or meet hanging criteria.

### Digital Entry File Requirements:

- Digital images must be in .jpg format contained on one CD-ROM.
- Jpeg Images must be labeled as in the example: John N. Smith = JNS 01 JNS 02 JNS 03
- File size should not exceed 6MB and have a minimum resolution of 150 dpi and maximum resolution of 300 dpi.
- CDs must be labeled with artist’s name, title of work(s), medium(s) and size(s). CDs will not be returned. No email submissions.
- UVAA reserves the right to reproduce artwork from digital images for publicity purposes.

### Shipping and Delivery of Accepted Artworks:

Art Center hours are Tue – Fri, 10am -6pm. Work may be hand delivered or shipped to UVAA to arrive not before Tuesday, April 20 and no later than Monday, April 26 by 6pm. Artwork will be the responsibility of the artist until it is received by UVAA. Each artist will be responsible for shipping cost to and from UVAA to include a **pre -paid shipping label along with a \$10 handling fee per piece shipped**. Complete instructions will be included with acceptance letter. UVAA will insure all accepted works for 60% of its value from the time of arrival at UVAA until it is released to the shipping agent. UVAA reserves the right to refuse upon arrival any work that does not match the image or meet hanging criteria or is of unacceptable quality.

### **Juror: Ken Roth**

A well known regional artist, Ken Roth was awarded “Best Emerging Artist” by [Art and Antiques](#) at the Carmel Festival of Art in 2002, Ken is also currently featured in the [Guild Sourcebook of Architectural and Interior Art](#) and in [Art Business News](#), June 2009, as an Emerging Artist. Roth is a Central Oregon artist whose paintings are filled with rich color and light on the landscape and figure. Born in San Diego, California in 1966, Roth developed a love of the outdoors and seeks to capture nature’s harmonies in his paintings.
