Stars are the limit! Spectacular spaceships and freaky fly'n saucers. Design and construct with ordinary materials.

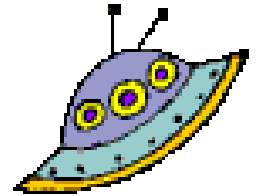

8-week sessions beginning week of July 5th

Kids and Clay (ages 6-12 years):

This 8 week session will teach kids about making clay pots, tiles, masks, whistles and sculpture. Beginning wheel throwing and hand building. Lots of fun and functional kids projects. Registration includes glazes, firing and 1st bag of clay.

Teen/Adult Clay Studio (ages 13 and older):

In this 8 week session participants will learn about clay, glazes and firing stoneware ceramics. A studio class to learn about making clay pots, tiles, masks, whistles and sculpture. Learn wheel throwing, hand building or just register and use the studio space and equipment for your project. Registration includes glazes, firing and 1st bag of clay.
