

## HOW DOES A "JURIED ART SHOW" WORK?

### THE PROCESS

When you send in your submission for jury at UVAA, the Gallery Manager along with the assistance of others processes the application by capturing all the given information onto a master spreadsheet. All images submitted are placed into a master folder with inventory numbers and burned onto one "Juror Master CD".

This master CD containing inventory numbered images **only** is then sent by Fed Ex to the hired juror along with a printed worksheet that contains only the image inventory number, the title of the related pieces and the finished sizes. The juror also receives the worksheet via email so that the final choices can be received without requiring any footwork on the juror's behalf. The Master CD and hard copy are kept by the juror as reference.

The hired juror **does not** get the benefit of knowing whose image is whose, the juror is not local and is a hired professional. In this way the submitter and the gallery manager are both assured that the jury is fair and not political in any way!

Remember, the old adage, "Beauty is in the eye of the beholder?" This applies here. Jurors are professionals in the field of art either by vocation or by education or by both. They choose.

All jury submission fees help to pay for the juror fees, awards when applicable and any related administration expenses to host the show.
