

## "ACRYLIC Boot Camp" 2 Day Workshop with Corrine Dietz

**Description:** If you are a painter who wants to gain a better understanding of the technical aspects of acrylic systems or new to painting & harboring the spirit of an explorer, this is the class for you. This workshop will be two intensive and fun days in which we will explore Fluid, Heavy Body and OPEN Acrylics, as well as many of the gels and mediums! Learn techniques to control transparency, viscosity, textures and drying times. Encounter a new palette of color to develop your eye. Expect loads of information, money saving tips, and new reference for your work. The Boot Camp is geared toward making sense of the process and finding your groove with acrylics. I recommend Boot Camp for any artists needing a refresher or a full jump start. Most GOLDEN acrylics will be supplied by the instructor, creating a great opportunity to *try it all* to find your personal favorites!

We will explore the following; Polymers (mediums & gels) + Fluid Acrylics, Color Mixing with Heavy Body paint (transparent to opaque), Developing Surfaces with Gels and Grounds, Glazing and Blending with OPEN Acrylics, Mix Media, the "Final touches" and Critique

**Students will need to bring:** Five surfaces 11"x14" or smaller (canvas, panel, or acrylic paper ~ Canson Montval), an apron or paint clothes, and a sack lunch for each day.
