- -Ultramarine Blue (cool blue)
- -Cerulean Blue (warm blue)
- -Titanium White
- -Ivory Black (Payne's Grey is also okay)
- -Yellow Ochre (earth tones)
- -Burnt Umber (earth tones)
- -Phthalo or Viridian Green

Brushes

- -Robert Simmons Signet Bristle Filbert Brushes (*highly recommended but any good quality bristle filbert brushes will do)
 - Sizes 4, 6, 8 & 10(make sure it's filbert)
