





Frequently Asked Questions continue...

What if I finish early?

You are free to leave at any time during the day. Just be sure your artwork is framed and turned in to Gallery East before 5:30 PM on Friday.

Do I have to check in at 8 AM on paint out days?

No, you do not need to check in on paint out days. This year, we have decided not to time-stamp the artwork, making the process less stressful and more flexible for our artists. We recommend starting at 8:00 AM because that is when we will have volunteers available to answer questions, but feel free to paint whenever you like.

Are all paintings going to be part of the exhibit?

A minimum of one painting per artist that meets the eligibility requirements will be displayed. The juror will select up to 40 works to be given Awards

of Distinction which includes the First, Second, Third, and Fourth Place Awards. These top 40 will hang in the Hallie Brown Ford Gallery. The remaining artworks included in the exhibit will be displayed in the Red Gallery, Corridor Gallery and Gallery II. These awards of distinctions will travel to two Galleries before they make their way back to the artist in January 2018.

How long will the artwork be on exhibit?

The exhibit will hang from September 16 to October 27, 2017. Any unsold artwork can be picked up by the participant, or any designated pick-up person. If artwork is to be shipped, artists must provide a shipping container and a return shipping label.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is there a Quickdraw this year?

We will not be conducting a Quickdraw this year. It is the first year that we've done Umpgua Plein Air without one! In liu of the Quickdraw we've added another paintout day on Wednesday. We'll head downtown after brunch at the Art Center and the Juror talkwith Kathryn Stats. If you love the Quickdraw and wan to see it come back, please make sure to tell one of the event organizers.

Can I use more than one media?

Of course! Paint an acrylic in the morning and a watercolor in the afternoon. Just be sure to label them properly. If you are using mixed media in one piece, you need to state specifically what you used, i.e. "watercolor and charcoal" on your ID tag.

How many paintings can I turn in?

You may turn in three paintings total from the Wednesday, Thursday and Friday paint outs.

Do I sign my painting?

No. For the purpose of sales, sign the back of the work. The wall tagging ID plague will be posted by your hanging work after the jury is complete and will identify your work to the viewer through the exhibit. This will create a more equal jurying field.

When should I frame my work?

For best results, prepare the frame components

Artwork tagging process!

ID tags for the back of each painting will be available in your registration packet and at the hospitality tables. You will need to fill out two tags for each painting. Attach one to the back of your work and turn in the other one with your work at the Arts Center. Canvases will not need to be stamped and all work needs to be turned in no later than Friday at 5:30 PM in Studio East.

ahead of time. There will be a table available at the Arts Center where you can work on framing. You should bring all the tools and components needed to finish this task. There will not be a backup supply kit available. Keep in mind, there may be a crowd at the table at the last minute. Just be sure your artwork is framed and turned in to Studio East before 5:30 PM on Friday.

What framing is required?

All artwork is required to be "hanging ready" upon delivery to UVAA complete with picture wire hanging on the back (hanging hooks are not acceptable.) Gallery wrapped canvas is acceptable as long as there is picture wire hanging on the back and there is no wet paint on the sides or back; the sides may need to be pre-painted and dried before this event. Only "gallery wrapped" sides (without staples on the sides) are acceptable.

Can someone else deliver my painting for me?

You must deliver your own work to the Arts Center.

What if I can participate only on Wednesday or Thursday or only on Friday?

Not a problem, just let the Arts Center staff know ahead of time. You can leave your painting(s) for jury and hanging.

FALL CREEK: MILEPOST #32 - 33







Harvard Ave. 0.4 mi Turn right onto NW Stewart Parkway 1.3 mi Turn left onto NW Garden Valley Blvd 1.3 mi Turn left onto Melrose Rd 0.2 mi Turn left onto Jones Rd 0.4 mi **Destination will be on the left** Doc Bailey's Farm is nestled between the rolling hills of Douglas County. You will lose count of the number of historic barns and outbuildings. Enjoy the day painting grassy pastures, old oak trees, sheep, horses, and farm equipment!

The Hospitality Table and restrooms will be located in front of the house. Parking will be available to the left upon entering the property. On Saturday at 10 AM, enjoy a demonstration with Guest Juror Scott Gellatly at Cooper Ridge Vineyard. *Parking is limited to 20 cars.* Carpooling arrangements will be made during artists orientation.
