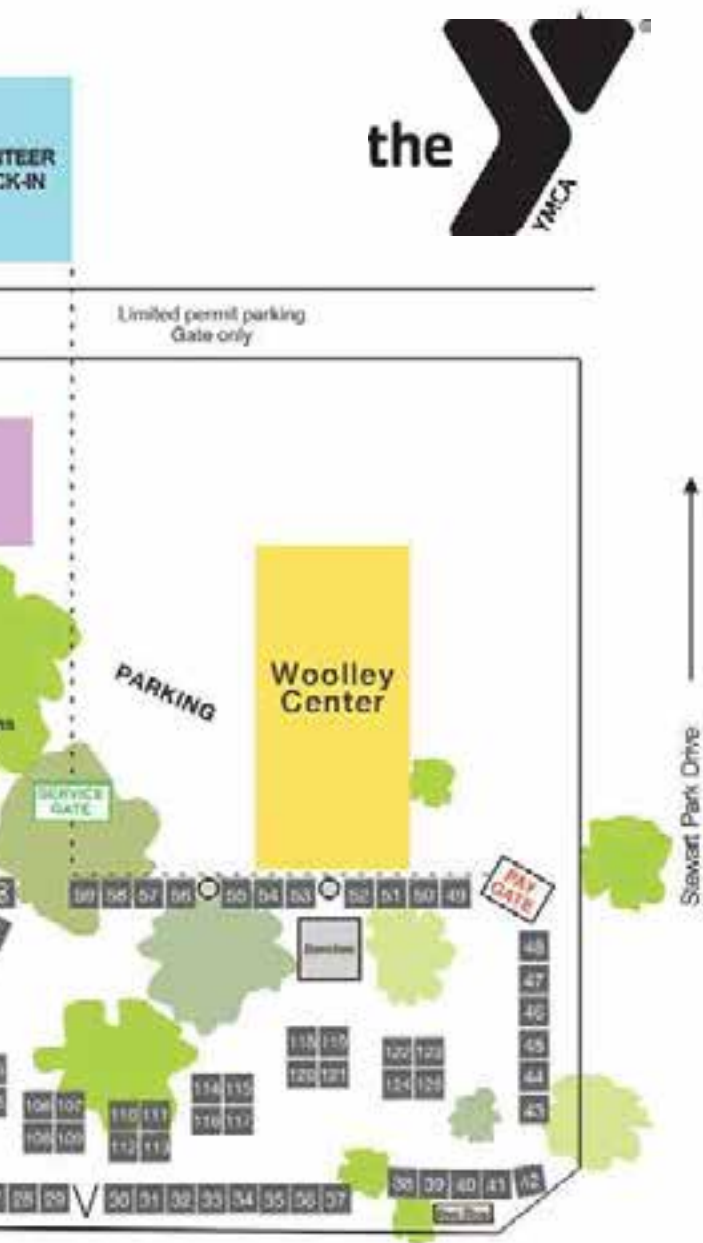

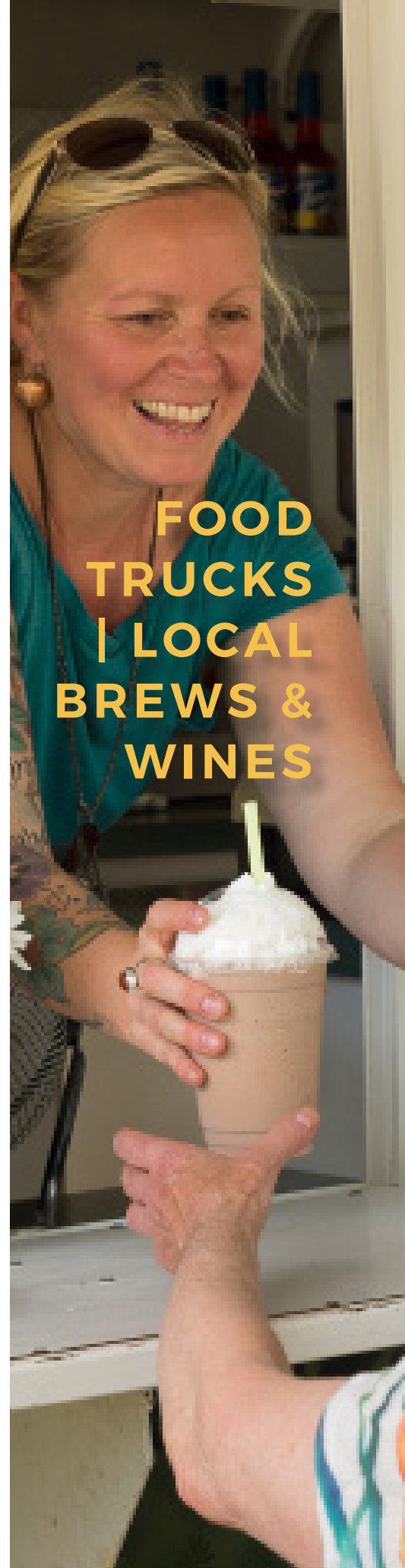
## McMENAMINS
