HOW ARTISTS WERE CHOSEN

"The Summer Arts Festival is a juried event for artisans and creatives of all media to showcase and sell their work. The works that are accepted and on display at the festival are the result of a careful and detailed evaluation process performed by an on-site jury. This jury is composed of UVA Staff, art professionals from varied backgrounds, and Summer Arts Festival Committee members who embrace the philosophy and goals of the Summer Arts Festival.

Artists are selected based on craftsmanship, creative ability, ingenuity, design skills, originality, and booth representation. Applications are reviewed in groups over several rounds, in the order in which they are received. In each round, jurors review all the applications and provide individual scores to each artist after much discussion. These scores are tallied, and artists who receive top scores are invited to participate in the Festival. Congratulations to all artists accepted into the 54th Annual Summer Arts Festival, and thank you for being part of this well-loved event."


